Une grande étoile pliée dans du papier design au motif de casse-noisette

Cette grande étoile est pliée dans un papier design carré de 30x30 cm puis assemblée avec du ryban adhésif Power Tape.

Commencez par couper la bande blanche de sorte que la feuille soit carrée.

Fold the sheet down so that it is tip to tip. Do the same diagonally.

Attach a 3 cm piece of power tape from the edge on both sides of all the tips. Now make another identical star.

Remove the red paper on the power tape from both star halves and assemble them with the tips staggered and the holes facing each other.

Fold the sheet in the middle in both directions – horizontally and diagonally.

Make a 7.5 cm cut towards the centre in all four directions along the score line. Reinforce the paper with a piece of sellotape where the cut ends. □

Place a sharp ruler from the tip to exactly where the cut ends. Now fold the design paper around the ruler.

Attach a strip of power tape on the flap on the inside on the right. Remove the red paper on the power tape and stick the flap onto the flap on the left 2 cm from the edge. NB: before sticking the last flap together, place a doubled-over piece of string with a knot inside the star.
