A Christmas tree crocheted from cotton yarn and gold yarn

Assemble the Christmas tree by sewing each layer of branches onto a piece of sewing thread with a small gap between each layer, enabling each individual layer to rotate independently of each other. Finish by sewing on the star at the top. The Christmas tree is approx. 10 cm high and approx. 8.5 cm wide. Alternatively, you may place the layers loosely on top of each other in case you do not want to hang the Christmas tree up.

NB: Please note that some rounds are offset. NOT all rounds start and end at the same place.

The top layer of branches

Use a No. 3.5 crochet hook

- 1: 4 dc in a magic circle
- 2: *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (7)
- 3: *2 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (10)
- 4: *3 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (13)
- 5: *4 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 6 times (20)
- 6: *skip a stitch, 5 tr in the same stitch, 1 dc in the 2nd stitch*.Repeat from *-* 4 times.

Change to white yarn.

7: 1 dc in each stitch.

Cut and secure the ends.

The second layer of branches

Use a No. 3.5 crochet hook

- 1: 4 dc in a magic circle
- 2: *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (7)
- 3: *2 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (10)
- 4: *3 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (13)
- 5: *4 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 3 times (16)
- 6: *5 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 11 times (28)
- 7: *skip a stitch, 5 tr in the same stitch, 1 dc in the 2nd stitch*.Repeat from *-* 6 times.

Change to white yarn.

8: 1 dc in each stitch. *Cut and secure the ends.*

The third layer of branches

Use a No. 3.5 crochet hook

- 1: 4 dc in a magic circle
- 2: *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (7)
- 3: *2 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (10)
- 4: *3 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (13)
- 5: *4 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 3 times (16)
- 6: *5 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 3 times (19)
- 7: *6 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 16 times (36)
- 8: *skip a stitch, 5 tr in the same stitch, 1 dc in the 2nd stitch*.Repeat from *-* 8 times.



Change to white yarn. 9: 1 dc in each stitch. Cut and secure the ends.

The bottom layer of branches

Use a No. 3.5 crochet hook

- 1: 4 dc in a magic circle
- 2: *1 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (7)
- 3: *2 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (10)
- 4: *3 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* twice (13)
- 5: *4 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 3 times (16)
- 6: *5 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 3 times (19)
- 7: *6 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 3 times (22)
- 8: *7 dc, 2 dc in the next stitch*. Repeat from *-* 21 times (44)
- 9: *skip a stitch, 5 tr in the same stitch, 1 dc in the 2nd

stitch*. Repeat from *-* 10 times.

Change to white yarn.

10: 1 dc in each stitch. Cut and secure the ends.

The star

Use a No. 3 crochet hook

- 1: 5 dc in a magic circle
- 2: 2 dc in each stitch (10)
- 3: *4 ch , dc in the 2nd ch from the hook, htr, tr, sl st in the 2nd stitch in the round*. Repeat from *-* 4 times *Cut and secure the ends*.
